### 614 gets greased!



The 614 received a basic inspection and preventive maintenance during a Locomotive Crew work session held on June 5, 2005. A thick coating of grease and rust preventative were applied to the 614's running gear and other mechanical components. Rust preventive paint was applied to areas forming rust or which were void of protective paint. A set of large tarps were applied to the Locomotive and tender in an effort to limit the amount of rain, snow and debris that had been entering certain areas. The work was performed on a steamy June day by a number of the Iron Horse Enterprises Locomotive Crew and New Hope & Ivyland Railroad Volunteer Locomotive and Equipment Crew Members.

### • RAILFAN WEEKEND!



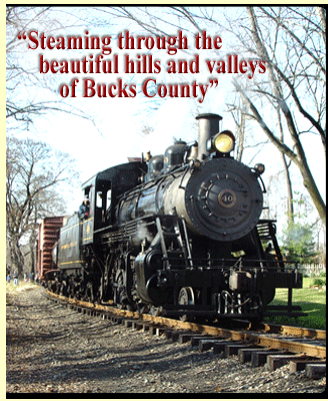
